



The Zeidler Excilibur model produces greater tonal and dynamic range than a conventional dreadnought due to its enhanced vibration qualities. The suspended x-brace design, giving additional vibration area to the sound board, balances the bass response with an equally strong treble response. The increased curvature of the back bracing enhances sustain and delivers superior carrying power. Versatile because of its broad dynamic tonal range, the Excilibur is a good choice not only for bluegrass but for any flat picking style.
